UPCJ Development Project Breaks Grounds at 77th National Conference

The United Pentecostal Church of Jamaica (UPCJ) broke ground to signify the commencement of phase two of the UPCJ Multi-Purpose Auditorium Complex. The ceremony which was held at the Moneague Multi-Purpose Complex on Wednesday, February 22, 2022, during the 77th National Conference marked the beginning of the construction phase of the two-billiondollar (JMD) project.

The ground was broken by Executive Board Members - Reverends O'Garth McKoy, Clebert Russell, Howard Francis and Harold Crooks, Project Chairperson- Sister Tanesha Bryce-Rainford, Project Technical Officer- Reverend Steve Moncrieffe, Region Four Executive Presbyter-Reverend Joseph Lewis, Legacy Member- Reverend Robert Stewart, Youth President- Minister Ossain Jones and Child- Brother Jalon Ferguson.

Following the official breaking of the ground, eight shovels and hats used were handed over to the seven (7) Executive Presbyters and Overseas Delegate- Bishop Devon Dawson. The handover was a symbolic gesture, as they are now tasked to raise \$1.5 million (JMD) in their regions.

National Superintendent - Bishop O'Garth McKoy, who was addressing attendees, further emphasized that the best is yet to come with continued unity and trust in God. "The future looks bright and it is all because of Jesus Christ. This is just the beginning, but the journey of a thousand miles begins with just one step. If this is one step, then it is indeed a big step," said Bishop O'Garth Mckoy.
